






Understanding Genesis 1 & 2

GOD SAID ... AND IT WAS SO "ACCORDING TO THEIR KINDS"


Genesis 1v11 Then GOD SAID, "LET the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds. AND IT WAS SO."

1v21 God created the great <u>creatures of the sea</u> and every living and moving thing with which the water teems, according to their kinds, and <u>every winged</u> bird according to its kind.

1v24 And GOD SAID, "Let the land produce living creatures according to their kinds: livestock, creatures that move along the ground, and wild animals, each according to its kind." AND IT WAS SO.

N.T. ON ADAM, JESUS & (HUMAN) DEATH


Luke 3v23, 36b, 38b Jesus was the son of ... Noah ... the son of Adam, the son of God.

Romans 5v12-15 sin entered the world through <u>one man</u>, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned— death reigned from the time of <u>Adam</u> ... But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the <u>one man</u>, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the <u>one man</u>, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many!

- 1 Corinthians 15v21,22; v45,47 since death came through <u>a man</u>, the resurrection of the dead comes also through <u>a man</u>. For as in <u>Adam</u> all die, so in <u>Christ</u> all will be made alive.
- ... it is written: "The <u>first man Adam</u> became a living being" [Gen 2v7]; the <u>last Adam</u>, a life-giving spirit. <u>The first man</u> was of the dust of the earth, <u>the second man</u> from heaven.
- 1 Timothy 2v13 Adam was formed first, then Eve.

GENESIS 1 AND 2 – 7th day eternal?

work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work. And God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work of creating that he had done.

But:

- No evening & morning marks out the 7th/Sabbath Day
- Was a day = "the seventh day" & "on it"
- ➤ The character of God's rest is available today = rejoicing & relating (Hebrews 4v1-11)

GENESIS 1 AND 2 – plants later?

Genesis 204-7 When the LORD God made the earth and the heavens— and no shrub of the field had yet appeared on the land and no plant of the field had yet sprung up, for the Lord God had not sent rain on the land and there was no man to work the ground, but streams came up from the earth and watered the whole surface of the ground—the LORD God formed the mane from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

But cultivated plants in the field – later as needs man to work the field

GENESIS 1 AND 2 – Day 6 length?

the beasts of the field and all the birds of the air. He brought them to the man to see what he would name them; and whatever the man called each living creature, that was its name. So the man gave names to all the livestock, the birds of the air and all the beasts of the field. But for Adam no suitable helper was found. So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, he took one of the man's ribs and closed up the place with flesh. Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man

- God brought the animals to Adam (v19)
- Adam named all the 'the livestock, the birds of the air and all the beasts of the field not the sea creatures, nor any of the insects
- Leaves c.11,000 types of animals but could have been say 2,500 proto-types, so

Day 6 possible timings

6:00-7:00 God creates land animals.

7:00–8:00 God creates Adam from dust.

8:00-9:00 God creates the garden and puts Adam in it.

9:00–11:00 Adam tends the garden.

3:00-5:00

5:00-6:00

Adam names the animals – names c.2,500 11:00–3:00 proto-types that God brings to him, 1 every 5 seconds, with a 5 minute break every hour


Adam sleeps, and God creates Eve from Adam's rib.

How many are your works, O LORD! In wisdom you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures. Psalm 104v24




