**Jesus is the HANDS of God,  
from *The Great Commission***

<b>Jesus share's God's</b>	<b>How?</b>	<b>Matthew 28v16–20</b>
<b>Honor</b>	As he is worshipped – worship is not to be given to people (Acts 10v25–26) or angels (Rev. 19v9–10)	v17, “they worshipped him”
<b>Attributes</b>	As he is all-present	v20b, “surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”
<b>Names</b>	As he shares the divine name	v18b, “go and make disciples of all nations baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit”
<b>Deeds</b>	As he issues absolute commands, that are to be totally obeyed	v20a, “teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you”
<b>Seat</b>	As he sits on throne over all the universe with all power	v17 “all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me”

**Jesus is the HANDS of God,  
from John's Gospel compared to the Old Testament (OT)**

<b>Jesus share's God's</b>	<b>OT LORD GOD</b>	<b>Examples about Jesus from John's Gospel</b>
<b>Honor</b>	Isa. 42v8	5v22–23 Honor him 14v1 Believe in him 14v14 Prayer to him 14v15 Love and obey him
<b>Attributes</b>	2 Sam. 7v22	14v8 Seen Jesus, seen the Father 8v46 Sinless 13v34 Love 14v6 Truth
<b>Names</b>	Ex. 3v13–15 Psa. 23v1	8v58–59a The <i>I am</i> 10v11, 27–33 The <i>Shepherd</i> who died to rescue his sheep, and holds them forever
<b>Deeds</b>	Isa. 43v10–12a	Saviour: 4v46 Saviour of the world cf. v12–14 gives living water welling up to eternal life 6v8–11 Feeds 5,000 11v25–44 Raises the dead 16v33 Gives peace in troubles, that the world cannot give (14v27)
<b>Seat</b>	Dan. 4v34b–35	3v35 All things are in his hands 21v1–6 Controls where fish are
